Application of County of Kern, a political subdivision of the State of California, for order designating crossing of Williamson and Southern Pacific Mainline Railway #B-364.4 at Monolith, a Public Crossing.)	Application No. 47221
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O R D E R

County of Kern is hereby authorized to construct Williamson Road at grade across the main line of the Southern Pacific Company's San Joaquin Line, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-364.4, at Monolith, in Kern County.

Construction costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

Width of the crossing shall be 44 feet and grades of approach not greater than 4 1/2 percent, in accordance with plans attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
