SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 68811 dated March 30, 1965, in the above proceeding, revised the hourly rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 for the transportation of oil, water or gas well outfits and supplies and for stringing services. It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision No. 68811 restricted the application of rates for stringing services to a greater extent than was intended. The necessary correction will be made by the order herein.


IT IS ORDERED that:




2. In all other respects said Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
