ORDER AMENDING DECISIONAND DENYING REHEARING

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, having petitioned for rehearing of Decision No. 68730, the Commission having considered said petition, and being of the opinion that said decision should be amended, but that no good cause for rehearing has been shown,

IT IS ORDERED that the following sentence on page 3:

"The cost of installing flashing light signals at Kansas Avenue should be apportioned 50 percent to the Southern Pacific Company and 50 percent to the City of Riverside, the Southern Pacific Company to pay for the cost of maintaining said protective devices."

is amended to read as follows:

"The cost of installing flashing light signals at Kansas Avenue should be apportioned 50 percent to the Southern Pacific Company and 50 percent to the City of Riverside."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ordering paragraph No. 3, page 4, is deleted and the following paragraph is substituted therefor:

"Allocation of maintenance costs for protective devices at the crossing is deferred until further order of this Commission."

Rehearing of Decision No. 68730 as amended by this order is hereby denied.
