SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 68921, dated April 20, 1965, in the above proceeding, revised certain minimum rates and rules for the transportation of fresh or green fruits and vegetables and related items as provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8.

In a number of cases, highway common carriers publish rates on the level of those authorized in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 on fresh fruits and vegetables and related commodities which are exempt from rate regulation under the above tariff. Decision No. 68921, supra, does not authorize common carriers to increase their published tariff rates on this traffic. This decision also does not authorize common carriers to maintain in their tariffs provisions which are currently more restrictive or produce charges greater than those contained in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 in connection with the rates and charges so established or in connection with rates and charges for transportation exempted from rate regulation as hereinbefore mentioned. The so-called "exempt" commodities here in question move in the same vehicles with and generally under the same conditions as

fresh fruits and vegetables. The circumstances which justified adjustments in the fruit and vegetable rates apply equally to such rates when applied on these other commodities. The Commission finds that the resulting increases in rates are justified.

The tariff pages appended to Decision No. 68921 do not reflect rates for the transportation of empty containers as provided in the decision. The necessary tariff revisions will be made by the order herein.

Inasmuch as the other rate revisions authorized by Decision No. 68921 are scheduled to become effective May 29, 1965, the order which follows will be made effective on the date hereof.

IT IS ORDERED that.

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8 (Appendix "C" to Decision No. 33977, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective May 29, 1965, Fifteenth Revised Page 29, Tenth Revised Page 31 and Tenth Revised Page 32 attached hereto and by this reference are made a part hereof.
- 2. The tariff rates, rules and regulations established by Decision No. 68921 and Ordering Paragraph 1 hereof may also be established by common carriers in connection with the transportation of commodities which are exempted from rate regulation under the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8.

- 3. Any provisions currently maintained in common carrier tariffs, which are more restrictive than, or which produce charges greater than, those contained in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 8, are authorized to be maintained in connection with the rates, rules and regulations established by Decision No. 68921 and Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 hereof.
- 4. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public; and the tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.
- 5. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

6. In all other respects, Decision No. 33977, as amended, and Decision No. 68921 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
