 on a Major 100 foot divided street.

ORDER

City of Fresno is hereby authorized to construct Ashlan Avenue at grade across the mainline track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the City of Fresno, Fresno County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2-1002.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 80 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
