Application of the CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
 CALIFORNIA, for an interim order
 authorizing the widening of Spruce Street,
 controlling the flow of drainage water
 and installation of No. 3 flashing
 light signals at the existing crossing
 at grade of the mainline tracks of
 ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY
 COMPANY, at Crossing No. 2X-2.02 in the
 City of Riverside, declaring sum to be
 advanced by the City to the Respondent
 under Public Utilities Code, Section 1202.1.

ORDER

The Commission having been advised that the parties are now in tentative agreement with respect to the need and plans for altering the crossing as well as the apportionment of costs, the City of Riverside is hereby authorized to widen and otherwise alter Spruce Street at grade across the San Jacinto Branch of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, at the location described in the application, identified as Crossing No. 2X-2.02, in the City of Riverside, Riverside County.

Width of the crossing shall be 36 feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Construction costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
