Application of the County of Tehama,
State of California, for an order
authorizing construction of a crossing
at separated grades whereby Gyle Road
F.A.S. 1079 (4) will be carried over
the tracks of the Southern Pacific
Company, referred to as "Gyle Road
Overhead".

ORDER

County of Tehama is hereby authorized to construct Gyle Road at separated grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company, near Tehama, Tehama County, referred to as Gyle Road Overhead, at the location and substantially as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AE-184.7-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with requirements of General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction of the Gyle Road Overhead, a clearance of 20'6" above top of rail is authorized provided Southern Pacific Company issue appropriate bulletins to train and enginemen advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Upon completion as authorized herein, existing grade Crossing No. AE-184.7, Gyle Road, shall be abolished by physical closing by Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
