ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 67020 dated March 31, 1964, in this proceeding, Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of persons and their baggage between Bishop Municipal Airport and Mammoth Lakes and in the vicinity of Mammoth Lakes. The decision ordered that applicant shall establish the service therein authorized and file with the Commission tariffs in triplicate within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date of the order. The required tariffs were not filed within the aforementioned period, which expired with August 28, 1964.

By letter from the Secretary of the Commission dated September 24, 1964, Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, was placed on notice that, unless the service was established and tariffs filed, the certificate granted by Decision No. 67020 might be revoked pursuant to lawful procedures. The tariffs have not been filed.

Jerry J. Bowes, Secretary and Treasurer of Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, has informed the Commission by letter that the corporation has not engaged in, nor does it intend to engage in, any business involving transportation of the public.

Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, having failed to establish the service authorized by Decision No. 67020, supra, and having failed to file the required tariff schedules, the Commission finds that such failures constitute good cause for the revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation granted to Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, by Decision No. 67020, dated March 31, 1964, in Application No. 46060, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, or after the above mailing to Bowes Enterprises, Incorporated, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have

been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
