ORDER GRANTING INTERIM RELIEF

Louise Reynolds, doing business as Acme Surgical Appliance Co., 2024 West 6th Street, Room 300, Los Angeles, California, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that defendant has refused to make an adjustment on an equitable basis for a classified advertisement alleged to have been inserted negligently and incorrectly, and further alleging that defendant has informed the complainant, her agents and representatives that all advertisements by the complainant in the 1965-1966 Yellow Pages Directory will be cancelled and said service is not available to the complainant; and it appearing that such cancellation may result in an unlawful discrimination against complainant, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, is hereby directed, pending further Commission order herein, to accept for said 1965-1966 Yellow Pages Directory all of complainant's classified advertising which complies with the conditions contained in defendant's applicable tariff provisions. The complaint will be set for hearing before

such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary is directed as follows:

1. To cause a certified copy of this order, together with a copy of the complaint herein, to be served upon The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, and said defendant is directed to serve and file its reply within ten (10) days after said service.
2. To cause a copy of this order to be mailed to complainant.
3. To cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to the parties at least ten (10) days prior to the hearing herein.
