ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this petition the Filtrol Corporation asks that a commodity rate of \$5.00 per ton be established and published in Minimum Rate No. 2 for the transportation of crude clay (raw earth) from a location five miles west of Nipton to Vernon and adjacent points.

Public hearing on this petition was held before Examiner Abernathy at Los Angeles on April 22, 1965.

Petitioner did not appear at the hearing, either directly or by representative. Petitioner has not provided the Commission with any good and sufficient reason for its nonappearance. No evidence has been presented in support of the petition.

In the circumstances the petition will be dismissed,
with prejudice. Therefore,
