SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 68823 dated March 30, 1965, in the above proceeding, canceled exception ratings on certain specified commodities from City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A effective May 1, 1965. The exception ratings in question were canceled because they duplicated ratings which are published in National Motor Freight Classification A-8 (CAL).

It has come to the Commission's attention that the deletion from the above tariff of certain exception ratings for specific commodities, as authorized by Decision No. 68823, supra, subjected such specific commodities to other exception ratings in the tariff and resulted in unintentional increases and reductions. Revisions adjusting these ratings to the basis intended by Decision No. 68823 will be made by the order herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 10, 1965, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects, said Decision No. 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
