ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 68345  
AND DISMISSING PETITIONS FOR REHEARING

The Department of Public Works of the State of California and the Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, having filed individual petitions for rehearing of Decision No. 68345 herein objecting to the inclusion in the 1965 priority list of grade separation projects of the Pleasant Grove Road separation in the County of Placer with priority number of 16; and it appearing in Decision No. 69089, pursuant to amendment to Application No. 46243, that the grade separation project as authorized does not include the closing of an existing grade crossing at Pleasant Grove Road so as to qualify for a contribution from the Grade Separation Fund and inclusion on the 1965 priority list set forth in Decision No. 68345;

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 68345 is amended to delete from the 1965 priority list contained therein all reference to Pleasant Grove Road crossing C-113.2, bearing priority number 16;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the said petitions for rehearing are hereby dismissed.
