O R D E R

County of Yolo is hereby authorized to construct Stone Boulevard at grade across spur tracks of Sacramento-Yolo Port District in West Sacramento, Yolo County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 78-2.8-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento-Yolo Port District shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
