ORDER VACATING ORDER OF  
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

The highway common carrier certificate of public convenience and necessity of Henry C. Santos has been under suspension since November 18, 1964, for failure to maintain a tariff on file with the Commission in conformity with its outstanding minimum rate orders. The suspension was effected by Decision No. 68130, dated October 27, 1964, in this proceeding.

On May 7, 1965, Henry C. Santos filed tariff revisions to become effective May 20, 1965, to conform with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders. Inasmuch as the required tariff amendments are now on file, Decision No. 68130, supra, will be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 68130, dated October 27, 1964, in Application No. 41285, is hereby vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
