ORDER CONTINUING SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Earl J. Hall and Erwin J. Hall, doing business as E. J. Hall & Son Transportation, has been suspended since October 21, 1964, under the provisions of General Order No. 100-C for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance.<sup>1</sup> The carrier's participation in various tariffs of Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, was canceled on June 7, 1965.<sup>2</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> The certificate authorizes service as a cement carrier for the transportation of cement to and within the counties of Kern, Los Angeles, San Bernardino and Santa Barbara from any and all points of origin.

<sup>2</sup> The tariffs are Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Scope of Operations and Participating Carrier Tariff No. 4, Cal.P.U.C. No. 6, Distance Table No. 5, Cal.P.U.C. No. 22, and Local Freight Tariff No. 17, Cal.P.U.C. No. 21.

Earl J. Hall has informed the Commission by letter that he is recuperating from a hip fusion operation and will be incapacitated for a period of approximately one year. He requests that the certificate in question be continued in suspension on a voluntary basis in order that operations as a cement carrier may be resumed at a later date when he is able to do so.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds, that the requested continuation of the suspension of this carrier's certificate for a period of approximately one year should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier granted to Earl J. Hall and Erwin J. Hall, doing business as E. J. Hall & Son Transportation, by Resolution No. 13821, Sub. No. 33, dated June 23, 1964, in Application No. 46550, is hereby continued in suspension until July 1, 1966.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Earl J. Hall and Erwin J. Hall or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known addresses as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service upon Earl J. Hall and Erwin J. Hall or after the above mailing to them, as the case may be, unless before such effective date Earl J. Hall or Erwin J. Hall shall have filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing or shall have filed evidence of liability insurance required by

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General Order No. 100-C and proper and lawful tariffs required by Section 486 of the Public Utilities Code in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
