INTERIM ORDER

The County of Fresno is hereby authorized to relocate, widen, and reconstruct various grade crossings of the Southern Pacific Company in connection with the improvement of Clovis Avenue between California Avenue and Shaw Avenue FAS project 06-Fre-SU-SG (814)4 at the locations and substantially as described in Exhibits A through C, inclusive, of the above-numbered application, the authorization being summarized for the crossings identified in the following table and being subject to the conditions named therein:

Washington St.	BS-212.1	Relocate and widen	2 Std. No. 8 flashing light signals supplemented with automatic crossing gates.
Belmont Ave.	BS-212.2	Relocate and widen	4 Std. No. 8 flashing light signals.
Olive Ave.	BS-212.7	Widen and reconstruct	2 Std. No. 8 flashing light signals supplemented with additional front facing units mounted on cantilevered arms.
Ashlan Ave.	BS-215.2	Upgrade existing protection	2 Std. No. 8 flashing light signals supplemented with additional front facing units mounted on cantilevered arms.

Gettysburg Ave. BS-215.7	Relocate and widen	2 Std. No. 8 flashing light signals supplemented with additional front facing units mounted on cantilevered arms.
Shaw Ave. BS-216.2	Widen and reconstruct	4 Std. No. 8 flashing light signals.

The applicant also seeks authority to make certain changes at Harvey Avenue (BS-212.5). These changes at Harvey Avenue are not being approved by this order but will be the subject of further order of this Commission.

Widths of roadway and grades of approach of the above crossings shall be as shown in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at each crossing shall be as authorized above.

Construction expense of the work herein authorized shall be borne in accordance with agreements to be entered into between the parties involved, and a copy of said agreements together with plans of said construction approved by the Southern Pacific Company shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion such cost by subsequent order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
