 red to as "Delhi Pedestrian Overcrossing".

ORDER

The State of California, Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at separated grades over the track of the Southern Pacific Company, near Delhi, Merced County, at the location and substantially as shown by plan (Exhibit B) attached to the application, referred to as "Delhi Pedestrian Overcrossing", to be identified as Crossing No. B-131.82-AD. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall be in accordance with requirements of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
