ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

Chester Stonecypher, Jr., doing business as The Mallard, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of dressed wild ducks and geese between Tulelake and Dorris. He has informed the Commission by letter that he discontinued operations as a highway common carrier on October 10, 1964, and requests that his certificate be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The certificate should be revoked, and the tariff applicable to services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by Chester Stonecypher, Jr., by Decision No. 52878, dated April 10, 1956, in Application No. 37803, is hereby revoked.

2. Adoption Notice of Chester Stonecypher, Jr., and Local Freight Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 (Series of W. H. Gilbert) are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Chester Stonecypher, Jr., or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Chester Stonecypher, Jr., or after the above mailing to Chester Stonecypher, Jr., as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for a public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
