ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

Aldo J. Scoffone, doing business as Scoffone Trucking Service, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing him to operate as a highway common carrier between San Jose, on the one hand, and San Francisco, Oakland, Sacramento, Pittsburg, Stockton, and Santa Clara, on the other hand.

Aldo J. Scoffone has informed the Commission by letter that he has never operated under the certificate in question nor ever filed a tariff as required and requests that the certificate be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The requested revocation should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Aldo J. Scoffone by Decision No. 64161 dated August 28, 1962, in

Application No. 43245 is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Aldo J. Scoffone or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Aldo J. Scoffone or after the above mailing to Aldo J. Scoffone, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
