OPINION ON REHEARING

Ex parte Resolution No. 13841, dated June 30, 1964, dis-
 missed the application of Robert Denver Chaffee for a certificate
 to operate as a cement carrier pursuant to the "grandfather"
 provision of Section 1063 of the Public Utilities Code.

Applicant petitioned for rehearing and his petition was
 granted by Order Granting Rehearing dated August 25, 1964.

The matter was set for rehearing in Los Angeles on
 May 20, 1965.

On May 19, 1965 the Commission received a telegram bearing
 applicant's name in which dismissal of the application was requested.
 At the rehearing before Examiner Gravelle no appearance was made by
 or on behalf of applicant.

Protestants moved for dismissal of the application for
 lack of prosecution.

The motions for dismissal are hereby granted.

ORDER ON REHEARING

IT IS ORDERED that the application of Robert Denver Chaffee for a certificate to operate as a cement carrier is hereby dismissed.
