O P I N I O N

Miles Motor Transport System requests that its operating authority as a highway common carrier be amended by excluding therefrom the authority to transport chips and shavings, wood, in bulk.

It is alleged that these commodities are exempt from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, and, because applicant cannot deviate from its tariff, it cannot successfully compete with permitted carriers. It proposes to perform such service pursuant to its permitted authority.

After consideration the Commission finds that excluding said commodities from applicant's certificated authority would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Miles Motor Transport System is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of chips and shavings, wood, in bulk.
2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Miles Motor Transport System shall amend its tariff presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

3. Appendix A of Decision No. 60784, as heretofore amended, is further amended by incorporating therein Second Revised Page 3 attached hereto in revision of First Revised Page 3.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

8. Explosives as described in and subject to the regulations of Agent H. A. Campbell's Tariff No. 10.
9. Articles of extraordinary value as set forth in Rule 3 of Western Classification No. 77, J. P. Hackler, Tariff Publishing Officer, on the issue date hereof.
10. Chips, wood, in bulk.
11. Shavings, wood in bulk, to be utilized in the production of particleboard, flakeboard, hardboard, pulpboard, or woodpulp.
