ORDER OF MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 69199, dated June 8, 1965, P. C. Cross was authorized to transfer the Hemet Bus Line to his son S. A. Cross. Under the provisions of the order the transfer cannot be consummated before July 8, 1965. It is requested that the order be amended so that the transfer may be made effective as of July 1, 1965.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 69199 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3. Applicants shall amend or reissue the tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations herein to show that P. C. Cross has withdrawn or canceled, and S. A. Cross has adopted or established, as his own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than one day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective

date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98."

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
