ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of L. H. Dowe, dba Pioneer Transfer Co. of Calexico, has been suspended since March 7, 1965, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance.¹ By letter to this Commission, L. H. Dowe has requested that his certificate be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The certificate should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier granted to L. H. Dowe, dba Pioneer Transfer Co. of Calexico, by Resolution No. 13825, Sub. No. 1, dated June 23, 1964, is hereby revoked.

¹ The certificate authorizes service as a cement carrier for the transportation of cement to and within Imperial County from any and all points of origin.

2. T. A. L. Loretz, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of L. H. Dowe, doing business as Pioneer Transfer Co. of Calexico, from his Local Cement Tariff No. 6, Cal.P.U.C. No. 10, on file with this Commission, said cancellation to be made within 90 days after the effective date of this order, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon L. H. Dowe or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to T. A. L. Loretz, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon L. H. Dowe or after the above mailing to L. H. Dowe, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for a public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
