ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 32315, dated September 12, 1939, Sam Bedwell was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation and as a highway common carrier of property between Nevada City and Forest and intermediate points via Alleghany.

Sam Bedwell has informed the Commission by letter that the revenue received by him for transportation services rendered do not compensate him for the extra costs in insurance premiums that he incurs and requests that his certificate of public convenience and necessity be revoked. The annual reports for 1961, 1962 and 1963 filed with the Commission by the carrier indicate freight revenue of \$68.00, \$83.00 and \$76.45, respectively. Passenger revenue for the year 1961 amounted to \$13.50. No revenue from passenger operation was reported for the years 1962 and 1963.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds, that revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The requested revocation should be granted and the tariffs applicable to the services thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation and as a highway common carrier granted to Sam Bedwell by Decision No. 32315 dated September 12, 1939, in Application No. 22862 is hereby revoked.

2. Adoption Notice C.R.C. No. 4, Local Freight Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2, and Local Passenger Tariff C.R.C. No. 2 of Sam Bedwell are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Sam Bedwell or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Sam Bedwell or after the above mailing to Sam Bedwell, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written

request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
