ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of Vernon W. Bolen (Bolen) has been suspended since November 18, 1964, for failure to maintain a classification in effect.¹ Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, canceled from its tariffs the participation of the carrier on March 1, 1965.² To date Bolen has not filed the required classification and tariffs.

Vernon W. Bolen not having the required classification and tariffs on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate.

¹The certificate authorizes service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of property between Santa Barbara and Thousand Oaks and intermediate points via U.S. Highway 101, including the off-route points of Port Hueneme, Oxnard, Saticoy and Somis; between Ventura and Ojai, and intermediate points via U.S. Highway 399 and State Highway 150; and between Ventura and Fillmore, and intermediate points via State Highway 126.

²The tariffs are Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Scope of Operations and Participating Carrier Tariff No. 100, Cal.P.U.C. No. 3; Distance Table No. 5, Cal.P.U.C. No. 22; Exception Sheet No. 1-A, Cal.P.U.C. No. 18; and Local, Joint and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 17-A, Cal.P.U.C. No. 33 (Series of Elmer Ahl, Agent).

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Vernon W. Bolen by Decision No. 54592, dated February 25, 1957, in Application No. 36260 is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Vernon W. Bolen or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Vernon W. Bolen or after the above mailing to Vernon W. Bolen, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
