## <u>O P I N I C N</u>

Mildred Dooms, as Executrix of the Estate of R. O. Dooms, requests authority to transfer and Paul K. Hamett requests authority to acquire a cement carrier certificate to and within the Counties of Contra Costa, Fresno, Kings, Madera, Mariposa and Tulare.

Said authority is prescriptive in nature and was described by the Commission in Resolution No. 13821, Sub. No. 50, issued June 23, 1964, in Application No. 46357.

R. O. Dooms died on March 13, 1965 and his wife, Mildred Dooms, was appointed Executrix of his estate by the Superior Court in and for the County of Fresno. For business credit and tax purposes the equipment was sold to Utility Trailer Sales Company which is, in turn, selling said equipment to applicant Hamett. There is no cost attributable to the cement carrier certificate.

Applicant Hamett is presently doing business as Hamett Trucking Co. and is located in Fresno, California. He owns and operates eleven units of equipment and as of March 5, 1965 indicated a net worth in the amount of \$70,833.63.

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After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

## $\underline{O \ \underline{R} \ \underline{D} \ \underline{E} \ \underline{R}}$

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. On or before December 1, 1965, Mildred Dooms, as Executrix of the Estate of R. O. Dooms, deceased (seller), may sell and transfer, and Paul K. Hamett (purchaser) may purchase and acquire, the operative rights referred to in the application.

2. Within thirty days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, purchaser shall notify the Commission, in writing, of that fact and within said period shall file with the Commission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect said transfer.

3. Purchaser shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations herein to show that he has adopted or established, as his own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than thirty days after the effective date of this order on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 117.

4. On or before the end of the third month after the consummation of the transfer as herein authorized, purchaser shall

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cause to be filed with the Commission, in such form as the Commission may prescribe, an annual report, or reports, related to the operations of the seller for the period commencing with the first day of the current fiscal year to and including the effective date of the transfer.

5. Concurrently with the tariff filings required by ordering paragraph 3 hereof, the operating authority described by Resolution No. 13821, Sub. No. 50, issued June 23, 1964, in Application No. 46357 is hereby revoked and in its place and stead a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Paul K. Hamett authorizing him to operate as a cement carrier, as defined in Section 214.1 of the Public Utilities Code, between the points as set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
