## ORDER OF MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 37932, dated September 30, 1964, the Commission authorized Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc., to sell its operating rights to Wells Cargo, Inc., on or before January 1, 1965.

Decision No. 68228, dated November 17, 1964, modified Decision No. 67932 by extending the time interval to June 1, 1965.

The applicants filed a petition on June 1, 1965, to advise that the matter is still pending before the Interstate Commerce Commission on the application to transfer the interstate operating authority of Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc. and to request . that the time within which to transfer the rights be extended to December 1, 1965 so the decision of the Interstate Commerce <sup>1</sup> Commission will be issued before it becomes necessary to transfer the California operating authority of Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc.

Therefore, good cause appearing,.
