ORDER OF MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 67932, dated September 30, 1964, the Commission authorized Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc., to sell its operating rights to Wells Cargo, Inc., on or before January 1, 1965.

Decision No. 68228, dated November 17, 1964, modified Decision No. 67932 by extending the time interval to June 1, 1965.

The applicants filed a petition on June 1, 1965, to advise that the matter is still pending before the Interstate Commerce Commission on the application to transfer the interstate operating authority of Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc. and to request that the time within which to transfer the rights be extended to December 1, 1965 so the decision of the Interstate Commerce Commission will be issued before it becomes necessary to transfer the California operating authority of Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc.

Therefore, good cause appearing, .

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 68228 should be amended to read as follows:

"2. On or before December 1, 1965, Lawson Taylor Lines, Inc. may sell and transfer, and Wells Cargo, Inc. may purchase and acquire the operative rights and property referred to in the application."

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
