ORDER OF MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 68804, dated March 30, 1965, Clayton Miller was authorized to acquire a certain certificated right for the transportation of uncrated and unboxed household goods, furniture (including antiques), office fixtures and furniture between Los Angeles and Santa Barbara and certain intermediate and off-route points. Because applicant Miller also possessed authority to transport used household goods, furniture and office fixtures pursuant to a statewide household goods carrier permit, the same decision revoked the certificated right to the extent that it constituted duplicating authority. It is requested that the household goods permit be amended rather than the certificate to eliminate possible duplication.

It is alleged that partial revocation of the certificate seriously affects its value and its attendant interstate right.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 68804, dated March 30, 1965, in Application No. 47303 is hereby amended by incorporating First Revised Page 1 attached hereto in place of Original Page 1.

2. Applicant Clayton Miller shall comply with the tariff requirements provided for by ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 68804 and said filings shall also reflect the authority herein granted.

3. Household Goods Permit No. 19-50930 issued to Clayton Miller is hereby revoked to the extent that it duplicates the authority granted by Decision No. 68804, and as herein amended, and the Secretary of the Commission is directed to issue to Clayton Miller a household goods permit to the extent that it does not constitute a duplication of said authority.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
