Application of the City of Tracy, California, for permission to construct McKinley Avenue at grade across existing tracks of the Southern Pacific Company's Tracy-Martinez Line.

O R D E R

The City of Tracy is hereby authorized to construct McKinley Avenue at grade across tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Tracy, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. B-81.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be as described in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
