ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION
OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

Decision No. 69245, dated June 15, 1965, in this proceeding provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of James G. Putman for failure to have on file with the Commission the required tariffs. That decision also provided that the effective date of the order would be stayed in the event he filed with the Commission before such effective date the required tariffs.

On June 8, 16 and 23, 1965, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, filed tariff revisions reinstating James G. Putman as a participant in the tariffs involved effective July 31, 1965, thereby staying the effective date of the order. Inasmuch as the required tariffs are now on file, Decision No. 69245, supra, will be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 69245, dated June 15, 1965, in Application No. 33948, is hereby vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
