SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 69472, entered today in this proceeding, canceled certain exception ratings provided on various commodities in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B. The above decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B should be amended by a separate order in this proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 4, 1965, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than September 4, 1965; and the tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the exception ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the exception ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects, said Decision No. 65834, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
