Decision No. 69495

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of UNION ICE & STORAGE COMPANY, a corporation, for authorization to discontinue cold storage warehouse operations in 2,000 square feet of warehouse space in the Los Angeles Harbor District of the City of Los Angeles.

O P I N I O N

By Decision No. 68797 applicant was authorized to operate 16,000 square feet of public utility cold storage floor space for the storage of any and all commodities requiring refrigerated warehousing in the Los Angeles Harbor District of the City of Los Angeles.

By this application authority is sought (1) to discontinue operation of 2,000 square feet of warehouse space by abandoning its plant at San Pedro, which has an area of 1,936 square feet, and an additional 64 square feet, and (2) retain 14,000 square feet of its present operation at its Plant No. 29 in Wilmington, both plants being in the Los Angeles Harbor District.

As justification applicant alleges that the San Pedro plant is now vacant and further requests for storage are not anticipated. Need for storage can be accommodated at the Wilmington plant. Applicant will save the rent and the wages of one employee at the San Pedro plant.

After consideration the Commission finds that the granting of the application would not be adverse to the public interest and that public convenience and necessity do not require the continued maintenance of 2,000 square feet of storage floor space now authorized.

The application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Union Ice & Storage Company is hereby authorized to discontinue public utility warehouse operations of 2,000 square feet of floor space in the Los Angeles Harbor District of the City of Los Angeles upon the effective date of tariff amendments to be filed with the Commission reflecting such discontinuance, said amendments to be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
2. Concurrently with the effective date of tariff filings required by ordering paragraph 1 hereof, Appendix A of

Decision No. 68797 is hereby amended to read as set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
