ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 66821 dated February 18, 1964, in Application No. 46057, H. A. Shelley doing business as Wilmington Bus Company, was granted a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between Stephen White Junior High School in Torrance and nearby territory; that, during the month of June 1965, he discontinued this service; and that H. A. Shelley has indicated that he has no intention of restoring service due to the fact that the Stephen White Junior High School has redrawn its school district boundaries in such a way that the service is no longer needed.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 66821 in Application No. 46057, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of H. A. Shelley doing business as Wilmington Bus Company are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon H. A. Shelley or to mail a certified copy thereof to H. A. Shelley at 1536 Bay View Avenue, Wilmington, California, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after such service upon H. A. Shelley or after the above mailing to H. A. Shelley, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
