ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct additional spur track at grade across Estes Road in Butte County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. CH-185.7. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded or a minimum width of twenty-four feet with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The Southern Pacific Company desires to immediately commence construction so that rail service can be provided to Superior Dryers, Inc., during this fruit season.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
