SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 69331, dated June 29, 1965, the Commission canceled General Orders Nos. 98 and 116 and adopted General Order No. 98-A making it applicable to all passenger stage corporations and passenger charter-party carriers. General Order No. 98-A is contained in Appendix A to Decision No. 69331 and will become effective September 1, 1965.

Section 7.02 of General Order No. 98-A prohibits drivers of passenger stages and trolley coaches from drinking alcoholic beverages or liquor while on duty or prior to going on duty. "Section 7.02 Alcoholic Beverages - Use by Drivers Forbidden" should have been included in the Table of Contents of the General Order but was inadvertently omitted.
