ORDER VACATING ORDER OF
SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHT

Decision No. 69293 dated June 22, 1965, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of C.F.O. Enterprises, Inc., a corporation, for failure to have on file with the Commission the required tariffs. The decision also provided that the effective date of the order would be stayed in the event the carrier filed the required tariffs with the Commission before such effective date.

On June 28, 1965, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, filed tariff revisions reinstating C.F.O. Enterprises, Inc., as a participant in the tariffs involved effective July 3, 1965, thereby staying the effective date of Decision No. 69293. Inasmuch as the required tariffs are now on file, Decision No. 69293 will be vacated.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 69293, dated June 22, 1965, in Application No. 46460, is hereby vacated and set aside.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
