SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 67240, dated May 19, 1964, authorized the Southern Pacific Company to construct two additional spur tracks at grade upon and across the easterly half of Alameda Street and one yard track across Eighth Street, in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, identified as Crossings No. BG-484.36-C, BG-484.44-C, and BG-484.54-C, respectively.

The order provided that the crossings be constructed in accordance with plan attached to the application and that the crossings each be protected by Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting material.

On May 11, 1965, the applicant, Southern Pacific Company, filed a petition for extension of time to comply with the above order. Applicant alleges that because of delays in obtaining the required permit from the City of Los Angeles, it would be unable to complete the construction before Decision No. 67240 expires.

An inspection at the site of the proposed crossings has been made and it is found that additional safety measures should be taken by the railroad when operating across the proposed crossings. Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that trains and

engines must stop and member of crew protect traffic when operating along Alameda Street between Seventh and Eighth Streets in a direction opposite to the normal flow of traffic and over the crossings authorized herein, and further, the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision be, and it is hereby extended to May 19, 1966.

In all other respects, Decision No. 67240 is reaffirmed and is in full force and effect.
