SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 69174 dated June 1, 1965 in this proceeding authorized the City of Santa Ana to construct Edinger Avenue at grade across the Southern Pacific Company's Santa Ana Branch, to be designated as Crossing No. BK-519.1.

The order provided that the crossing be constructed in accordance with plans attached to the application and that the crossing be protected by four Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) two of which to be supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

By Supplemental Decision and Order No. 69334 dated June 29, 1965 in this proceeding, Crossing No. BK-519.1 was changed to BK-518.5.

Applicant has notified the Commission by letter dated July 2, 1965 that, having been advised by Southern Pacific Company that the crossing is too wide to use two automatic gates, it requests that Decision No. 69174 be revised to include two additional Standard No. 3 flashing light signals supplemented with automatic crossing gates to be mounted on center of street median islands.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Crossing No. BX-518.5 be protected by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

In all other respects Decision No. 61974 is in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
