SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. <u>69599</u>, entered today in Cases Nos. 5441 and 7858 canceled exception ratings in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B and Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 on synthetic plastic sheets. The decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 should be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 (Appendix A of Decision No. 66195, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 2, 1965, Seventh Revised Page 3 and Third Revised Page 25 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than October 2, 1965.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the exception rating authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to

depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the exception rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 66195, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.

 Returned Shipments, viz.: Articles refused by consignee may be returned to original shipper and to original point of shipment at one-half of the outbound rate (applicable to quantity returned) current at time of return movement, subject to estab- lished minimum rate and charge, only upon the following conditions: (a) When actual delivery to consignee has been accomplished, articles for return move- ment properly identified must be present- ed to carrier within ten (10) days from date of delivery of the original ship- ments. (See Note.) (b) All charges must be prepaid or guaranteed. Shipping order must show reference to original outbound shipment. (c) Goods must be returned over the same route and line as the original outbound move- ment. (d) Explosives and Blasting Caps returned to original shipping point under provisions of paragraphs (a), (b) and (c), tendered for roturn movement under provisions of paragraph (a), but which cannot be accepted until after oxpiration of 10 days' limit on account of carriers having certain specified days for handling Explosives; such shipments will also be roceived, and rating protected, on the day assigned for receipt of Explosives next following expiration of the 10 days' time provided in paragraph (a).
