ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainant, by letter dated August 2, 1965, having agreed that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has satisfied the complaint and should be dismissed because of its action in advising the two defendants to comply with the provisions of Schedule No. 36-T and to discontinue using Carterphones for interconnection of radio transmissions with land line telephone circuits; and said defendants having submitted to Pacific written agreements of cessation of interconnection,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby dismissed from Case No. 8203 and the complaint is amended accordingly.
