ORDER

City of Glendale, California, in connection with the improvement of Western Avenue, is hereby authorized to construct one crossing at separated grades, over Southern Pacific Company's main line, to be identified as the Western Avenue Grade Separation (Crossing No. E-473.4-A) in the City of Glendale, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application.

The grade separation for Western Avenue has been established as priority No. 4 by Decision No. 68345 in Case No. 7979 pursuant to Statutes 1957, Chapter 2091, Amended Statutes 1959, Chapter 1763.





Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D, except that vertical clearances shall be not less than 24'2" in accordance with plan attached to the application.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order. Upon completion of the above structure, the existing grade crossing No. E-473.4 shall be abandoned and physically removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
