FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Following the issuance of Decision No. 69585 on August 24, 1965, under the above-entitled applications and case, it was discovered, that, through inadvertence, Appendix A omitted the Rate per Month and misstated the Minimum Guarantee per Day for Business,

Semipublic Service; the Rate per Month should have been \$.75 and the Minimum Guarantee per Day should have been \$.18 rather than \$.02 as stated in the decision, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the rate shown in Appendix A of Decision No. 69585 for Business, Semipublic, Rate per Month is amended to show \$.75 in place of \$ - and the Minimum Guarantee per Day is amended to show \$.18 in place of \$.02 as follows:

<u>Business</u>	<u>Rate per Month</u>
Semipublic, Rate per Month	\$.75
Minimum Guarantee per Day	.18

In all other respects, said Decision No. 69585 shall remain in full force and effect.
