ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision No. 68260, dated November 24, 1964, Inglewood City Lines was authorized to establish increased fares. The exercise of the authority was made subject to a condition that

"On or before December 31, 1964, applicant shall file with the Commission a program satisfactory to the Commission, which it will follow in the periodic replacement of its buses with more modern equipment."

On January 4, 1965, applicant petitioned for an extension of time to comply with this condition of the decision. However, it has since met the condition. No action on the petition for extension of time is necessary. The petition will be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for extension of time

which was filed by Inglewood City Lines on January 4, 1965, is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
