ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works, in connection with construction of Interstate Route 8, is hereby authorized to construct one crossing at separated grades of the Southern Pacific Company's main line, to be identified as the "El Centro Overhead" (Crossing No. BN-700.8-A) in Imperial County, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application.

Clearances shall be in accordance with requirements of General Order 26-D, except that during the period of construction of the overhead, a clearance of 21'0" above top of rail is authorized provided Southern Pacific Company shall issue and file with the Commission appropriate bulletins to train and engine crews advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding them to ride on tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to

commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

Within thirty days after the completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
