OBINION

This is an application for an order of the Commission authorizing Garden City Transportation Co., Ltd. to execute a security agreement and to issue a promissory note in the principal amount of \$179,799.84.

Applicant is engaged in business as a highway common carrier in the central portion of California. For the year 1964 it reported gross operating revenues of \$1,879,080.

The company proposes to issue a promissory note in the principal amount of \$179,799.84 in favor of Crocker-Citizens

National Bank in exchange for a loan of \$155,000 and discounted interest thereon at the rate of 4% per annum. The proceeds will be used to discharge existing notes having an aggregate outstanding balance of \$113,100.24, and the remainder will be utilized as working capital. The indebtedness will be repayable in forty-eight equal successive monthly installments of \$3,745.83 each, including principal and interest, and will be secured by means of a security agreement on certain of the applicant's motor vehicle equipment as described in an attachment to the application.
