ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct drill and spur tracks at grade across Clyde Avenue in the City of Mountain View in Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-38.11-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Applicant desires that said crossing be considered for exemption from the provisions of Section 22452 of the Vehicle Code of the State of California. Such exemption will be considered under provisions of Decision No. 58885 in Case No. 5979 at the time of issuance of the next supplemental order in Case No. 5979.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served is in present need of rail service and applicant desires to begin construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
