Application of the County of Mendocino )  
 to alter the existing Dos Rios crossing ) Application No. 47317  
 over the Northwestern Pacific Railroad )

O R D E R

County of Mendocino is hereby authorized to construct Laytonville-Dos Rios Road at separated grades over the track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, at Dos Rios, Mendocino County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibits B and C) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5-166.4-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D. Upon the completion of this project, the existing at grade crossing of Laytonville-Dos Rios Road, No. 5-166.4, shall be closed to public use and travel.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
