ORDER GRANTING INTERIM RELIEF

JOE A. GOMEZ, of 15344 Bledsoe Street, San Fernando, California, having filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that prior to May 31, 1965, complainant was a subscriber and user of telephone service furnished by defendant under the number EMpire 7-7917; that on or about May 31, 1965, said telephone facilities were removed and disconnected by the defendant pursuant to instructions from the office of the Los Angeles Police Department; that complainant has not used and does not now intend to use said telephone facilities as instrumentalities to violate the law nor in aiding or abetting such violation; that complainant has no knowledge of any illegal activities being conducted at said premises or over said telephone facilities; that complainant has made demand upon defendant to have said telephone facilities restored, but defendant has refused and does now still refuse to do so; that complainant has suffered and will continue to suffer irreparable injury to his reputation and will suffer great hardship if deprived of said telephone facilities; that complainant has four small children; that, it is, therefore, imperative that complainant have continuous telephone
