Code Section 3800 is reduced to \$533.46.

2. Respondent is relieved of the necessity of collecting  
undercharges from:

a. Taylor Lumber Sales

b. Lloyd E. Larson, doing business as Larson Lumber Sales.

In all other respects, Decision 69087 remains in full force  
and effect.
